The program consists of online curriculum, guest speakers, and a project to be completed in partnership with an investment firm. The project component of the program will give an inside look into the daily work and many different career opportunities that exist in the field of asset management.

By participating in IMAP, you will receive:

- **Online curriculum through Wall Street Prep**
You will be given access to Wall Street Prep in the beginning of December and can work through the material at your own pace throughout winter break.
- **Access to live guest speaker sessions via Zoom**
Students should expect 2-4 Zoom sessions in December and 5-7 in January.
- **4-week externship with a partner firm for the month of January**
Students should expect to spend 10-20 hours per week with partner firms working on a project designed to expose them to the role of an investment analyst.
